- 4) Tickets will be sold at a rate of -1 for \$10; 3 for \$25; 7 for \$50 and 15 for \$100
- 5) The tickets will be electronically generated by a Random Number Generator (RGN) supplied by Raffle Nexus Canada.
- 6) After purchasing, patrons will receive a confirmation email with their Outdoors Package Raffle registered numbers from a Random Selection System. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly.
- 7) There will be four (4) Early Bird Draws of \$250.00 each which will take place on June 3, July 2, August 1 and September 2, 2024. Each draw will take place at 12:00 pm at the Peterborough Northumberland Crime Stoppers Office located at 500 Water Street Peterborough, ON.
